

The Small Basilica of Philippoplis was constructed in the middle of the V c. It is part of the rich mosaic heritage of Plovdiv and it is a creation of some of the most skillful craftsmen of the ancient Philippopolis. All of those tiny colorful stones are so satiated with symbols, energy and history, that they can carry you in one long gone world.



Klianti House is one of the oldest preserved houses (from the middle of $18^{th}\,c.$) in the Old Town of Plovdiv. It amazes with a stunning combination between architecture, decoration and wall-paintings. Behind the magnificence of "The Pearl of the Old Town" there are decades of researches and restoration work. The decorative ornaments are some of the best patterns
